

Simple Steps to Identify TN 01 District and RTO Location

Vehicle registration numbers often provide useful clues about where a vehicle is registered. In Tamil Nadu, the registration mark begins with the state code “TN”, followed by a number assigned to a particular Regional Transport Office (RTO). If you are searching for [tn 01 which district](#), the code refers to Chennai Central RTO, located in the Ayanavaram area of Chennai. The official Chennai district administration also identifies it as RTO-Chennai (Central).

Understanding an RTO code can be helpful when checking vehicle registration information, identifying the concerned transport office, or determining where certain vehicle-related services are handled. TN-01 is one of the registration codes associated with the Chennai region and is commonly seen on vehicles registered through the Chennai Central RTO.



TN 01 Which District?

TN-01 is associated with Chennai district in Tamil Nadu and represents the Chennai Central RTO. The office is situated at Ayanavaram, Chennai. According to the Tamil Nadu Transport Department's published office information, the TN01 office is listed as “RTO, Central Ayanavaram.”

The basic details can be summarised as follows:

- **RTO Code:** TN-01
- **State:** Tamil Nadu
- **District:** Chennai
- **RTO:** Chennai Central

The published transport department information also lists a CUG contact number for the TN01 office. Since contact details can change, it is sensible to verify them before visiting the office.

Understanding the TN-01 Registration Code

A Tamil Nadu vehicle registration number generally contains the state identifier followed by an RTO number and an alphanumeric registration series. For example, a number beginning with **TN-01** indicates that the registration was associated with the TN-01 RTO.

The first two letters, “TN”, represent Tamil Nadu, while “01” identifies the particular RTO. Therefore, seeing TN-01 on a registration plate can help you connect the vehicle with the Chennai Central registration office.

However, an RTO code should not be treated as proof of the vehicle owner's current residential address. Vehicle owners can relocate, transfer vehicles and complete other permitted registration-related processes. The code primarily identifies the registration authority associated with the vehicle.

Simple Steps to Identify TN 01 District

Finding the district connected with TN-01 does not have to be complicated. You can use the following approach.

Step 1: Look at the Registration Plate

Start by checking the vehicle's registration number. If it begins with TN-01, the vehicle is linked to the Chennai Central RTO in Tamil Nadu.

Step 2: Separate the State and RTO Code

The registration mark can be understood in sections. “TN” indicates Tamil Nadu, while “01” identifies the RTO code. This makes it easier to distinguish TN-01 from other Chennai-area codes such as TN-02, TN-03, TN-04 and TN-05.

Step 3: Match the Code With the RTO

TN-01 corresponds to Chennai Central RTO, with the office located in Ayanavaram. The Tamil Nadu Transport Department's office list specifically records TN01 as RTO Central Ayanavaram.

Step 4: Confirm the Office Details

If you need to visit the RTO, check the latest office address, telephone number and working instructions before travelling. The official district administration currently lists RTO-Chennai (Central), while the transport department provides office contact information.

Step 5: Identify the Correct Service

Knowing the RTO code is only the first part of the process. The requirement may involve vehicle registration, a driving licence, ownership-related documentation, road tax or another transport service. Make sure you identify the exact service before arranging a visit.

TN-01 RTO Location and Address

The TN-01 RTO is located in Ayanavaram, Chennai. Transport department records identify the office as RTO, Central Ayanavaram and provide the office telephone number as 044-26745959.

Published address information identifies the location around Anderson Road, Ayanavaram, Chennai – 600023.

Because government office locations, counters and service arrangements can occasionally change, checking current information before making an in-person visit can help avoid unnecessary delays.

Major Services Associated With an RTO

The Regional Transport Office performs several important transport-related functions. Depending on the applicable rules and service category, these can include:

- Registration of new vehicles
- Transfer of vehicle ownership
- Issuance and processing of registration-related documents
- Driving licence-related services
- Learner's licence-related processes
- Vehicle fitness-related services
- Road tax and other applicable transport charges
- Issuance of permits for eligible vehicles
- No Objection Certificate-related processes
- Updating vehicle or licence records
- Other services administered under the transport department

Not every service is necessarily completed through the same counter or process. Some services may require an online application, appointment, document verification or an in-person visit.

Why Knowing Your RTO Code Matters

An RTO code is more than a number displayed on a vehicle registration plate. It can help vehicle owners understand which transport authority is associated with their registration.

Knowing the correct code can be useful when:

- Checking registration-related information
- Identifying the concerned transport office
- Understanding where a vehicle was registered

- Preparing for an RTO-related application
- Checking documents before visiting an office
- Understanding registration details after purchasing a used vehicle
- Communicating with the relevant transport authority

For insurance-related activities, accurate vehicle registration information is also important because the registration number forms a key part of a vehicle's identity in policy records.

TN-01 and Vehicle Insurance

When buying or renewing motor insurance, vehicle registration details should be entered carefully. A vehicle carrying a TN-01 registration may have been registered through Chennai Central RTO, but insurance decisions should not be based solely on the RTO code.

Policyholders should check important information such as the registration number, vehicle make and model, engine and chassis details, policy dates, insured declared value where applicable and other information requested during the insurance process.

Keeping these details accurate can make policy management easier and reduce the chances of discrepancies during future transactions or claims.

Difference Between TN-01 and Other Chennai RTO Codes

Chennai has multiple RTO codes, so it is important not to assume that every vehicle registered in Chennai will carry TN-01. The Tamil Nadu Transport Department's published list separately identifies TN01 as Chennai Central, TN02 as Chennai North West and TN03 as Chennai North East, among other Chennai-area offices.

This distinction is useful when someone is trying to identify an RTO from a registration number. The number following “TN” should be checked carefully instead of relying only on the city name.

Things to Check Before Visiting TN-01 RTO

A little preparation can make an RTO visit more convenient. Before travelling to the office, consider checking:

1. The exact service you need.
2. Whether an online application is required.
3. Whether an appointment is necessary.
4. The documents applicable to your request.
5. Current office timings and service-counter availability.
6. The latest contact information.
7. Whether applicable fees or taxes need to be paid in advance.

Carrying original documents along with required copies, where applicable, can also help avoid repeated visits.
